# Corrective Action When MELSOFT Products cannot be Installed or Operations Become Unstable after Applying Windows 11 Updates

Thank you for your continued support of Mitsubishi Electric FA engineering software MELSOFT series.

This bulletin describes the symptoms and their corrective action for a case in which MELSOFT products cannot be installed or their operations become unstable due to updates applied by Windows Update in Windows<sup>®</sup> 11.

This issue is related to a problem caused by Windows Update, and as of November 2025, an investigation has been requested to Microsoft Corporation.

We are also providing information to Microsoft Corporation to facilitate a prompt resolution and will continue to monitor the progress.

Once a solution is identified, it will be announced in the next revision of this technical bulletin.

#### 1 SYMPTOMS

In Windows 11, cases in which the following symptoms occur have been confirmed after applying updates by Windows Update:

No.	Symptom			
1	The error message of "File Error" appears during installation or update.			
2	An error message such as 'System start-up failed. Please restart Windows.' appears when starting a product or performing the project management			
	function (creating a new project, opening a project, etc.).			

#### Conditions

These symptoms occur when satisfying either of the following conditions:

- The operating system version is Windows 11 25H2 or later.
- The operating system version is Windows 11 24H2, with an update applied that was released on August 29, 2025, or later.

# 3.1 Corrective Action When an Error Occurs During Installation

This section shows the corrective action when an error occurs during installation.

When an error message appears, click the [Ignore] button.

Installation or update will be executed normally.

# 3.2 Corrective Action When an Error Occurs During Function Execution

This section shows the corrective action when an error occurs during function execution.

This corrective action is a temporary measure until a permanent one is identified.

If the same symptom persists despite taking the corrective action, please be patient until the problem is resolved.

# Ensuring that the update is not applied

To avoid an error during function execution for Windows 11 24H2, the relevant update must not be applied.

First, change the Windows Update settings to prevent the update from being applied.

Then, check if the update is applied, and uninstall it if it is.

Note that the pause and uninstallation of updates are to be executed at each user's responsibility.

#### Preventing the relevant update from being applied

Automatic update can be paused by changing the Windows Update settings by the following procedure:

- **1.** Select [Settings] ⇒ [Windows Update] from Windows Start.
- 2. Set "Get the latest updates as soon as they're available" to "Off."
- 3. Set "Pause updates" to "Pause for 5 weeks."

#### Checking if the update is applied

- **1.** Select [Settings] ⇒ [System] ⇒ [About] from Windows Start.
- 2. Check the OS build value under "Windows specifications."
- Less than 26100.5074: The update is not applied.
- 26100.5074 or greater: The update is applied. 🖾 Page 4 Uninstalling the applied update

### Uninstalling the applied update

If the relevant update is applied, uninstall it by the following procedure:

- **1.** Select [Settings] ⇒ [Windows Update] from Windows Start.
- 2. Select [Uninstall updates] under [Related settings] in [Update history].
- 3. Uninstall the relevant update in the list.

### Precautions

When uninstalling updates, do so in the order of their release dates, starting from the latest.

The following table lists the updates released between August 29 and October 28, 2025.

Updates released on or after October 29, 2025, also need to be uninstalled.

Note that depending on when the operating system is installed or when updates are applied, not all KB numbers may be displayed in the update list.

When the OS build value is 26100.5074 or higher even if uninstalling all the relevant updates, refer to the following corrective action:

## Reducing the occurrence of errors

The occurrence of errors can be reduced by installing the updated version of GX Works2 Version 1.631H or later in the environment where the relevant product is installed.

It remains effective even after GX Works2 is uninstalled.

If the problem persists, exit the relevant product and take this corrective action again.



If a product ID for the licensed version of GX Works2 is not available, install the trial version of GX Works2 Version 1.631H or later.
